

What is the Christian Anti-Communism Crusade?

The Christian Anti-Communism Crusade is an organization devoted to the battle against Communism and the propagation of the Christian faith. It was founded in 1953 and incorporated under the laws of the State of Iowa. The headquarters moved to Long Beach, California, and is at present located in Suite 709 of the Heartwell Building, 19 Pine Avenue, Long Beach, Calif.

Since its inception in 1953, the Crusade has made continuous and rapid growth. Its educational program outlining the specific nature of Communism has met with wide approval and support. The emphasis is upon a clarification of the nature of Communism itself rather than upon citing individuals or organizations who are active in the cause of Communism. It is imperative to know Communist philosophy, morality, organization, strategy and tactics if we are to avoid being deceived, ensnared and exploited. A constant effort has been made to avoid personal attacks on individuals and the imputation of evil motives. The chief source of information concerning Communism is secured from the published literature of Communism itself.

The activities of the Crusade include the publication and distribution of authentic material concerning the nature and program of Communism including films and radio

tapes as well as books and literature. In addition, speakers and lecturers are provided for gatherings of every type ranging from Congress and the State Legislatures, military and veterans organizations, to church and home groups. We now have a number of fluent and informed speakers busily engaged all through the year .

ANTI-COMMUNISM SCHOOLS

Anti-Communism schools of a week's duration are now being held in many states across the nation. These schools are fulfilling a desperate need in the anti-Communism struggle and great numbers are availing themselves of the privilege of attending. It is customary to locate the school in a well known hotel, to secure the finest possible faculty and meet during five days from 8:30 in the morning until 9:30 in the evening. Enrollments in these schools have been as high as 5,000. Their influence has been immeasurable as the messages are tape recorded and the tapes made available to individuals who can thus repeat the school in their own home, church, school or club.

SATURDAY SEMINARS

Where it is not possible to hold a full, week-long school, one-day seminars are frequently conducted. These are usually held on Saturday and feature a speaker, films, and tapes.

STUDY GROUPS

When individuals become concerned about the Communist danger and are anxious to know what to do, they are advised to form a study group. Thousands of such study groups have been established and are operating right across the country. They are not organizationally a part of the Christian Anti-Communism Crusade, but we gladly cooperate in providing a manual of organization and suggested study materials.

INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

It is imperative that the Communist external program of encirclement be met and defeated. To do this projects are needed in those areas of the world remote from the United States where the Communist agents are increasingly active and effective. If the anti-Communist counter-offensive is to be successful, it must be carried out by nationals of the countries concerned. These nationals must be informed concerning the true nature of Communism and equipped with the tools of communication to convey this knowledge to their own people. In addition they must have a motive that will sustain them in sacrifice in this mortal struggle. The motive the Crusade advances is that of Christian love. Our policy is to find such motivated nationals and provide them with the knowledge, literature, printing presses, etc., they so earnestly need. In addition we frequently provide modest per-

sonal support. In execution of this program, anti-Communist literature is now circulating in many languages throughout Asia, Africa, Europe, Central and South America. Workers are active distributing this literature in town and village. A daily newspaper has been established in India and a great victory against Communism has been won in Ker-ala, India. An intensive program is developing in Central and South America.

FINANCIAL POLICY

However, we believe that a grave disservice is done to the anti-Communism cause by the cancellation of powerful motivation by organic unity. We advocate that individuals who do not agree with our specific Christian position should establish an anti-Communist movement utilizing a motivating force they can commend. Multiple motivations must be mobilized and a great variety of anti-Communism organizations must be formed even as the Communists have established 700 fronts.
