Enclosed find measurements for under covers for Dogr. Suite beds to be worn under the lace spreads.

If possible turquoise blue would be the proper shade.

The body of the spread could be lined with a light-weight material, but valance would look softer without lining.

I hope I have made the drawing + measurements clear to you + if you would rather have me take care of this for you I will be glad to do so. I thought you might like to do the shopping, as it is difficult for me to leave there just now, besides one cannot purchase quality or color in San Louis Obispo.

I really require six pairs of blankets. I have
nine pairs of the heavy winter blankets you
purchased five years ago & they are as good
as new yet, but I don't like using them
ordinarily, I keep them in case any one asks
for an extra blanket. 6 blue Comforters
2 gold & 2 green not too dark. Binding on
blankets could match color of comforter.
