The Space Fair is an annual open house event held at Point Mugu and sponsored jointly by the naval commands at the Pacific Missile Range, Point Mugu, and the Construction Battalion Center, Port Hueneme. The Space Fair has grown to be the largest and most exciting aerospace-oriented event in the country and has an average annual attendance of more than 200,000. Here are the particulars of the fourteenth annual Space Fair, to be held Saturday and Sunday, 27 and 28 October 1973.

HOURS: Gates open at 9:00 a.m. each day.
Activities close at 7:00 p.m.

ADMISSION: Free.

EXHIBITS: These are some of the highlights of the Space Fair. Private industry and government agencies show a multi-million dollar display of space-age equipment. Actual missiles and space vehicles will be exhibited, and the latest and most fascinating aircraft in our government's arsenal will be on display. Electronic equipment of the future will be shown and explained by exhibitors.

CARNIVAL AND MIDWAY: A carnival with the finest and most exciting rides in Southern California will operate throughout the Fair. Additional midway attractions offering games, rides, food, and beverages will be available.

AIRSHOWS: Two airshows are planned each day, one at 10:00 a.m. and another completely different show at 2:00 p.m. Featured attractions include Formula I air races, world famous U.S. Army's parachute exhibition team--the Golden Knights, civilian aircraft aerobatics, and demonstrations of the latest Naval aircraft.

PROFITS: All profits from the Fair are donated to the Navy Relief Society, for aid to Navy and Marine Corps families.

PARKING:

Since capacity crowds are expected, we suggest that you arrive at least one hour before any of the airshows you plan to see. Special parking permits will be mailed. Traffic directors will pass automobiles bearing these permits to the reserved parking area.

RESERVED SEATING:

Seating has been reserved for your convenience. Separate tickets are available for each show. Reserved tickets to attend the airshows Saturday and Sunday will be made available on request. Donation is \$1 per seat. You may include your additional requirements on the reverse side of the enclosed response card.
