1. FACULTY MEETING. There will be an All-College Faculty Meeting at 3:30 PM in DDH GJ102 on Wednesday, 11 April 1979.
2. NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE HUMANITIES FELLOWSHIPS. Details on these have been sent to all faculty from the Center for Professional Development. This is simply to urge all those interested to give serious attention to the possibility of applying, particularly for the Category B fellowships for individuals engaged primarily in undergraduate teaching. The deadline for applications covering 1980-81 is 1 June 1979 for Categories A and B and 12 November 1979 for Category C.
3. AMERICAN COUNCIL OF LEARNED SOCIETIES FELLOWSHIPS. In the same vein as the above, attention is called again to the ACLS Fellowships in the Humanities, particularly those for recent Ph.D recipients, for young scholars in the humanities to study disciplines different from their fields of specialization for grants-in-aid, and for travel grants. In 1977, ACLS Fellowships went to individuals at San Diego State (2), Grand Valley State, Eastern Connecticut State, UW Eau Claire, Farleigh Dickinson, Worcester Poly, South Dakota State, UT San Antonio, VPI, Eastern Montana, St. Cloud State, Cal State San Bernardino, to name but a few that continue the ACLS trend away from complete domination by faculties of private colleges or universities or major state institutions.
4. INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS. The California State College, Bakersfield, campus representative on the CSUC Academic Council on International Programs is Dr. Fabian Fang.
