A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OXNARD COMMENDING PRESIDENT RICHARD M. NIXON FOR HIS CONTINUOUS AND DEDICATED EFFORT TO IMPLEMENT THE LONG STANDING AMERICAN IDEALS OF LAW, ORDER AND JUSTICE AND URGING ALL CITIZENS TO LEND THEIR FULL SUPPORT TO PRESIDENT NIXON IN THIS EFFORT

WHEREAS, President Nixon's recent remarks regarding a pending court case in Los Angeles have received a great deal of national attention; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes there is a danger that the news media's repetitive and sensational coverage of the President's remarks and ensuing criticism may momentarily obscure President Nixon's lifelong commitment to the ideals of law, order and justice; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, while recognizing that the news media has a responsibility to keep citizens informed of events which effect their lives, believes the news media should be extremely careful that its reporting policies do not encumber the exercise of justice in America's court system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council strongly believes that all citizens, regardless of their political party affiliation, should lend their full support to President Nixon and all other individuals who are making a sincere effort to replace escalating crime rates, expanding civil disorders and widespread injustice with a return to reason and responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Oxnard commends President Richard M. Nixon for his efforts to re-establish and strengthen the ideals of law, peace and justice in the American Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council urges all local, state and national leaders, and the general citizenry, to lend their full support to President Nixon in these efforts.
