PREVETERINARY PREPARATION

Students planning to attend a school of veterinary medicine may satisfy the first two years of the program at CSU, Fresno. The School of Agricultural Sciences is equipped to provide valuable experience with large animals through the student project program. Students desiring further information regarding the preveterinary curriculum should consult the Chairman of the Animal Science Department.

MASTER OF SCIENCE DEGREE

The master of science degree in agriculture is designed to extend competence for agricultural research, agricultural field work, and the teaching of agriculture, and to provide the first graduate degree for students anticipating advanced graduate study in animal or plant sciences, or with additional course work and research emphasis an option is available in agricultural chemistry.
