LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Death Penalty Legislation will probably come to a decision soon. The Assembly Criminal Justice Committee (chaired by Alan Sieroty) is deadlocked with the exception of Assemblyman Julian Dixon, who has stated that he is open-minded on the subject. A letter or telegram sent to the assemblyman at the State Capitol could be very influential. In 1970 the states which use the death penalty, namely Georgia, So.Carolina and Florida, also had the highest murder rates. In Maine, Vermont and North Dakota where death penalty has been abolished murder rates were the lowest.

Due to current State, Legislative and the upcoming Congressional recess our Legislation Committee will not meet until September.

Member of the Committee are still at work, however, and all material obtained should be sent to the chairman with a summary.
