Dear Miss Morgan :

May I urge PARTICULARLY that the flues in the new rooms be made large enough for the big fireplaces, so that we do not have to ruin the effect of the fireplaces by cutting them down to fit the flues.

It is better to spend money now to get the fires right rather than to spend much more later for a less satisfactory job.

We have so many fireplaces and so much trouble that I consider this matter one of the really important things in connection with the comfort of the Hacienda.
