Re: The National Convention, July 12-15, 1976

As you arrive in New York City, you will find that the facilities, the convention staff and New York City are ready for you. It is difficult to appreciate how much work goes into a convention like ours unless you have watched it grow over the nearly two years that it takes to get ready.

From the minute you get out of your plane, train, bus or car you and the members of your delegation will feel right at home even if you have never been to New York City before.

Those of you who have been in Madison Square Garden are in for a real surprise. You won't recognize it. We took possession of the hall at 12:01 a.m. on June 1st and since that time the activity has been continuous. Transportation

Because of the high interest in information about transportation you will find attached a detailed description of the excellent transportation arrangements that have been made to accomodate all delegates and alternates while you are in New York. Additionally you will find information about transportation plans for your departure from the City after the Convention.

Housing

By the time you receive this memo you should be located in your room. From this point your best contact point about your accomodations is the people who work for the individual hotels.

CREDIT: Be certain that you understand the credit policies of the hotel in which you are staying. When you checked in you were probably asked what means of payment you plan to use when checking out. If you have any questions as to hotel credit policies - ASK. The hotel personnel are prepared to answer all inquiries as to credit policies.

HOST COMMITTEE: The New York Citizens Committee organized a group of New Yorkers who welcomed you upon your arrival in the City and at your hotel. The Citizens Committee volunteer corps can answer any questions which pertain to the activities in New York City - sightseeing tours, theater tickets, restaurants, museums are the topics these volunteers are best equipped to handle. The host volunteers are not employed by the hotels: all questions concerning hotel services should be directed to hotel personnel.

Schedule

Two schedules are attached: The first of these relates to Convention sessions and the second to non-session activity.

CONVENTION SESSIONS SCHEDULE: It is anticipated that convention sessions will start at the times below:

Monday July 12 ----- 8:00 p.m.
Tuesday July 13 ----- 3:30 p.m.
Wednesday July 14 -- 8:00 p.m.
Thursday July 15 --- 1:00 p.m.

This schedule will give you a general idea of what will happen and when it will happen during the four sessions. Keep in mind that the exact timing of particular items will be affected by the length of time needed for completion of other business on the schedule.

OTHER EVENTS SCHEDULE: This is a collection of information about events which are occurring at times other than during the convention sessions. It is not all inclusive and specifically does not include delegation sponsored meetings and events. Updates of this schedule will be available each day at the Host Committee Booth in each delegation hotel. To check on latest changes for purposes of scheduling events please call Cathy Chaplin at 397-4122.

Security

Security arrangements that have been made for the convention really won't affect you until you reach Madison Square Garden. There, as you might expect, certain precautions must be taken.

All packages, cameras, tape recorders etc. must be inspected before they can be taken into the Garden. The process will be more expeditious than in the past; but if you want to avoid even the minor inconvenience, leave such items in your hotel.

One special note, credentials should not be worn openly except in areas where they are required. There are many people who want to come to this convention who will not be able to do so because space is limited. A few of them might attempt to obtain credentials in an unorthodox fashion.

Convention Headquarters Hotel - The Statler Hilton

The hotel is located across the street from Madison Square Garden. No delegations or candidate staffs are housed in this hotel. However, many organizations in which you may have some interest have offices in the hotel. You will find a directory of those organizations in your convention packet.


Madison Square Garden

A floor plan of the convention hall is included to assist you in finding your own delegation and others.

In a few instances the Credentials Committee has authorized half-votes, adding to the number of people in particular delegations. Unfortunately, this was done after construction work had been completed on the convention floor and it is not possible to add to the number of seats assigned to each delegation. However, there is a block of seats in the delegate seating area of the hall which has not been used because the view is partially obstructed. These seats may be used by members of these enlarged delegations who are not able to find seats with the main body of the delegation.

Caucus Rooms

In addition to the caucus room that has been provided to each delegation in its hotel, there are a number of rooms that can be used in the Statler Hilton. There is also one room within Madison Square Garden, the Cinema, that can be used for this purpose. These rooms will not be used for state delegation caucuses except during actual convention sessions and then on first come, first served basis. Credentials for all of the above will be delivered each morning to the Delegation Chairman at the state's delegation hotel. Persons qualifying for the credentials in the above categories must pick up their credentials each day at the "Credentials Distribution Site."

Site location: The Credential Distribution Site will be located in the 2 Penn Plaza complex at Seventh Avenue and 31st Street. This site is located directly across the street from the Statler Hilton Hotel-- the Convention Headquarters hotel--adjacent to Madison Square Garden.

Issuance: Credentials will be issued only to users, unless a user has, in advance, authorized some other person to pick up their tickets.*

*Floor Access: Any of the above persons who qualify for Floor access must personally pick up their credentials for the Monday--first day--session. For the remaining 3 days they may designate someone else to pick up their tickets. Such designation must be made in advance of pick up.

Design:

The Distribution Site is designed to accommodate the various groups to receive tickets by specific windows. That is, the design is similar to a bank format with specific windows for Governors & Lt. Governors, Members of Congress, DNC Members, Honored Guests, Guests, etc.

All Governors, Lieutenant Governors, Members of Congress, and Democratic National Committee Members have received a memorandum advising of the procedures reviewed herewith. They have further received a ticket reservation form for completion and return to the Credentials Office. It is requested that State Arrangements Chairpersons check with the above members to insure that they have completed and returned the forms.

TRANSPORTATION FOR DELEGATES AND ALTERNATES

In this section you will find information on departure for home at the end of the convention, intown transportation (special Madison Square Garden buses and regular bus and subway), and other airport transportation options.

**** DEPARTURE BUS TRANSPORTATION ****

You will be provided with free bus transportation on departure through Sunday, July 18. Bus tickets which permit use of these bus services were distributed at Welcome Booths on your arrival.

Individuals departing any time between July 9 and July 18 will also be able to use the regular "Carey" Airport Bus service for JFK and LaGuardia, although this service runs to selected points in midtown Manhattan, not directly to the hotels. Transport of New Jersey (TNJ) will also honor tickets July 9-18 between Newark Airport and the Port Authority Bus Terminal in Midtown Manhattan.

ON DEPARTURE (From Delegation Hotels Only)

1. From July 16 to July 18, special buses will take charter and group departures directly from the hotel to their departure points.
2. Individual departures will be served by a shuttle running every 30 minutes from the hotels to the airports on July 16.
3. Service on July 17 and 18 for individuals will again be handled by the "Carey" Airport Bus Company and TNJ which serves Newark Airport.

**** IN TOWN TRANSPORTATION ****

The Convention will provide bus service direct from your delegation hotel to Madison Square Garden before each session. Use of these buses is restricted to credentialed convention guests only. Loading times vary from hotel to hotel depending upon the distance to the Garden and the number of buses required to accommodate the delegations staying there. But be assured that traffic congestion and the security checks at the Garden will cause delays. Therefore the buses will be leaving exactly as scheduled so that your delegation may get to the Convention on time. Please find attached a list of the loading times of these buses at each hotel.

After each session, buses will be parked around the Garden in 3 (three) specific hotel loading zones, clearly marked as to which hotels they serve. Delegates will find buses to their hotels at one of these zones. This return bus service will continue for a 1 (one) hour period after the end of each session. Attached is another sheet listing the location of these zones and the hotels they serve.

In addition to this special Convention bus service, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority will be providing delegations with red, white and blue transit passes valid for free travel on all City subways and buses for the period of July 10-18. MANHATTAN TRIVIA

"Streets" run East and West and are mostly one way. "Avenues" run North and South and are also mostly one way.

In New York parlance, "Uptown" is North of anywhere you are; "Downtown" is South; "Crosstown" is East or West. The Hudson River is to the West. The East River is to the East.

Fifth Avenue is the dividing line between the East Side from the West Side. "Avenue of the Americas" and "Sixth Avenue" refer to the same avenue.

Public Transportation Notes

The bus and subway routes and stops listed and shown on the Democratic Convention Public Transportation to and from Madison Square Garden map are only those for buses and subways described in this list. The number of each bus, notated across the top of the front of the bus, should be checked before boarding. Signs on subway entrances usually list the line (IND, IRT, OR BMT) and the direction (Uptown or Downtown).

All buses and subway trains run 24 hours a day unless otherwise noted. However, buses and trains are fewer and further between in the late hours of the night. For example, most all night buses run only once per hour in the early morning hours.

The subway is generally faster than the bus system, especially when the street traffic is heavy. Both the buses and subway trains are crowded during rush hours.

All stops on the New York City bus system are by demand, which means that you must signal the driver that you wish to get off at the next stop. To do so, pull the passenger signal cord located above the windows on either side of the bus.

Uptown and Downtown bus stops are usually at every other street; Crosstown buses usually stop at every avenue.

Buses which carry "limited stops" signs in their windshields skip some stops. Ask driver if your stop will be made.

Special Note to Subways: The subway stop "34th Street--Penn Station" is located directly underneath Madison Square Garden.

Special special note: If you have any question on public transportation and convention transportation, ask at the Hotel convention booth, or the transportation information center at the Garden.

Wall Street at Pier next to Staten Is. Ferry Terminal (Downtown)

Rates for Duane, Ronson, Island, Wall Street are charter service for one to four passengers or three passengers, maximum, with luggage. New York Airways Helicopter is a scheduled service.

The flight is 6-15 minutes, depending on airport and heliport. Landing fees are included in these prices, although after 8:00 PM heliports close and there is an additional charge made.
