REPORT OF THE STUDENT ROADS COMMITTEE

PART ONE

The Roads Committee submits the following names for the following roads:

- 1. Let the name be <u>California Blvd</u> for the road that is the main entrance of our campus; it half circles the administration building ending as the north approach to the east entrance of the building.
- 2. Let the name be College Avenue for the road which
 goes from the southwest corner of Deuel Dorm past the main entrance of the New
 Administration Building and ending at the Sheep Unit.
- 3. Let the name be Cuesta Ave. for the road which goes from the southeast corner of Deuel Dorm to the Auto Shop.
- 4. Let the name be Pepper Lane for the road which goes from the southeast corner of the A.C. shop to Mr. Vernon's home.
- 5. Let the name be Poly Canyon Ave. for the road which goes from the Dairy silos to the horse corrals in Corlew Canyon.
- 6. Let the name be <u>Campus Way</u> for the road that follows our southern boundry connecting California Blvd., at our main entrance, and <u>Crandall Way</u> at our side entrance.
- 7. Let the name be Motley for the county road which crosses our campus on its east side.
- 8. Let the name be Mt. San Luis St. for the road which connects . College Ave., at the football field, with Pepper Lane.
- 9. Let the name be State Street for the road which connects Cuesta Avenue and Pepper Lane.
- 10. Let the name be Poly Vue Drive for the road which goes from the administration building to connect Matley Ave.. It is in direct line with the big Block "P" on the Santa Lucia Range.

- 11. Let the name be Santa Lucia St. for the road which connects Pepper Lane with Motley Avenue.
- 12. Let the name be Mt. Bishop Road for the road which connects Motley Avenue with Sycamore Drive.
- 13. Let Sycamore Drive be the name of the road which connects State Highway No. 1 with Mt. Bishop Road and continuing on back of the hog unit to the pump house.
- 14. Let the name be Entrance Way for the road which connects California Blvd. with College Avenue at the front entrance of the new administration building.

PART TWO

There are four entrances to our campus:

- 1. The main entrance is California Blvd.
- 2. The side entrance is where Crandall Way joins Campus Way.
- 3. The back entrance is on Cal Poly Avenue.
- 4. The Morro entrance is where Sycamore Drive joins the State Highway.

The committee suggests that speed limit signs be placed at each entrance.

PART THREE

The committee further suggests that there be white lines to mark off parking space on all campus parking areas; also that a parking area be made behind the gym where State Street joins Cuesta Avenue.

PART FOUR

The committee further suggests that signs naming the streets be placed at intersections before Poly Royal time, and that direction signs be placed at the intersection of Mt. Bishop Road and Sycamore Drive telling the distance to State Highway No. 1, Morro Bay and San Luis Obispo.
