"LESS OF ME, MORE FOR THEE"

You may have noticed the same strange similarity I noticed the other day when I picked up the morning paper. There was the article of the rapist whose victim was an II year old girl; one about the unfaithful marriage partner who because of his actions, the marriage bond of 15 years was broken and resulted in divorce. There was also a paragraph about the thief who for \$250 spent a night in jail. There was a lengthy description of the supposedly-clandestine rendezvous of a glamorous married actress who thought not of the embarrassment her children will suffer later in life.

Regardless of what the existing circumstances were behind each case, I cannot help but feel that the major motivating factor behind each act was selfish ness.

All of us must have some regard for self, this is required for self-preservation. The extremist in this theory, however, becomes the egocentric--a person who causes much unhappiness and who, basically, is unhappy himself.

The overly selfish individual, or egocentric, is primarily interested in one thing--self. His life, his decisions all center around him. He is self-conceited, self-complacent, self-opinionated and self-rightous. Written all over him are the words "1", "Me", and "Myself" and this is clearly proven when he begins to speak. He may have consideration for others, if, of course, it doesn't conflict with his desires, he may be warmhearted and attempt to win friends, when he thinks that perhaps later these friends will be of some personal gain to him; he may be generous and benevolent only when he sees himself admired by his benefactors.

The selfish person usually lacks confidence in himself and often is living with inferior feelings. Oftentimes his actions are the result in trying to prove himself. Some desire to do good deeds to be thought of as great, selfishly, for it satisfies the ego; some will not admit their wrongs or apologize for they are contradicting their selfish selves, and others will take that which is not rightfully theirs to prove to themselves it can be done.

True, there is no person more important to someone than himself, but there is also a time to think of others. The way society is set up, we eat and sleep with others; every year, day in and day out. We must give and take. We cannot be happy only taking, never giving. The egocentric would find greater satisfaction in concentrating on the feelings and wishes of others. To forget self and treat others with genuine and sincere unselfishness with no thought of recompense would make for happier living.

They say there is really no solution to the world's problems and happiness, but if they were to ask me where to begin I would say:

"Less of me, more for thee!"



HAPPY DAY! Four nurses received Certificates of Completion last Friday, June 8th, for 12 weeks' Refresher training at Santa Clara County Hospital.

The nurse shortage was further reduced last Friday, June 8th, as Santa Clara County Hospital awarded Certificates of Completion to its third class of nurse refresher trainees at a Graduation Tea held in the institution's Department of Nursing Education.

The normally severe professional surroundings were decked with magnolia blossoms and bouquets as Hospital Administrator Floyd Sorensen presented Certificates to the ladies for successful completion of twelve weeks' training in latest nursing techniques.

Assisting were Mrs. Mineola Pollack, R. N., Director of Nursing Education, and Instructor Mrs. Katherine Schnorr, R. N. Standing by to welcome ladies back to active nursing were several graduates of the Hospital's two earlier refresher classes.

In all, 51 Registered Nurses have completed the training. A basic qualifying course of twelve weeks is given by the Hospital, for which the nurses are paid a \$15 per week "earn while you learn" stipend. An advanced 8 week course is also given during which the Registered Nurses are paid \$25 per week.

The next County Hospital Refresher course, starting in September, will feature as heretofore a guarantee that training will not interfere with home responsibilities in mornings, afternoons and evenings.
