The Special Meeting of the City Selection Committee of Ventura County, having been duly noticed as required by law, was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chairman Prueter with the following representation:

Mayor Loeb1 moved that the nominations be closed. Mayor Tolmach seconded the nomination, whereupon Mayor Livingston moved that a unanimous ballot be cast in favor of Mayor Grandsen. Mayor Loeb1 seconded the motion.

Nominations were closed and Mayor Grandsen was unanimously selected to fill the position on the Local Agency Formation Commission, as indicated by call of the roll as follows:
