

LATE REGISTRATION

Late registration is defined as any time after the day and hours announced for registration. Students registering after the close of those announced hours are assessed a late registration fee of an additional \$5.00. Each late registrant must obtain late registration permission from the Office of the Dean of Summer Sessions or the director of the session attended, *before* he is allowed to register.

Enrollment in classes after the first week of instruction is permitted only in special cases, upon approval of the Dean of Summer Sessions, or the director of the session attended.

LIVING ACCOMMODATIONS

A. Residence Halls

1. Regular Students

The Residence Halls on campus are available to students during any summer session or workshop on the California State University, Fresno campus. The halls are modern air conditioned buildings and are attractively furnished and decorated throughout. The majority of students are housed two to a room; however, a limited number of single rooms are available. Bathroom facilities are provided in a central location on each corridor. All halls also provide special lounge, recreation and study areas, and laundry facilities. There are no cooking facilities in the halls. Food service is available in the College Union, or nearby restaurants. No family-type facilities are available on the campus.

Applications for space in the Residence Halls should be submitted as early as possible. Forms may be obtained by writing to the University Housing Office, California State University, Fresno, Fresno, California 93740. Priority will be based on the date of receipt of the application, license, and payment of all fees. To facilitate the processing of applications, all requirements should be met at least two weeks prior to occupancy. Since the university administration offices, including the Housing Office, are closed on Saturday and Sunday, applications cannot be received or fees paid on these days.

Rental rates per week for regular student occupancy during the summer are as follows:

Regular double room	\$16.00
Regular single room	\$18.00

In addition to the rental charge, a security deposit of \$20.00 is required. The security deposit is returned after the facilities are vacated if no
