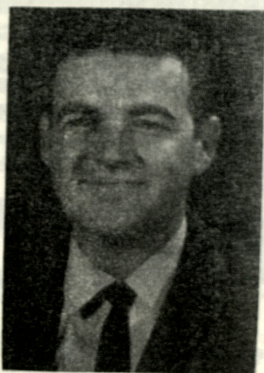

*"Christianity and Youth"*

In the past I have spoken about the Mexican American culture, Hatred, Negligence, Education, Discrimination and even Communism.

Let me begin by restating some of my past statements. We as human beings and of Mexican American descent whether we be classified as Mexican, Spanish, Puerto Rican, or Cuban, all have the same idea in common to proudly conserve our past ideas, welfare, religion, and spirit, let us step back for a few minutes and let it be known, I accept all criticisms which has long been my policy. Our only way to achieve our goal is by negotiating, not by squabbling with the anglos.

I as a youthful student feel in my soul a deep urge to express myself as an individual but also about man's relation to the acts of man as they relate to his fellow-man and not as we commonly express ourselves.

I'll save time by simply being direct in my approach. I'm not a Saint by far, yet I'm deeply concerned about our raza spiritually, and his optimism in the views of Christ. Here is why!

I feel because of my past experience and my foresight, in a position second to none to express my facts. "About youth as well as man".

Let me begin by simply asking ourselves what is the true meaning of Spiritual. In the eyes of our youth and I include Myself in this category, merely as a religious saying of Christ and in relation to accepting Christ as our Saviour, but don't we lose the whole concept and meaning, we tend to finagle our way out by overlooking it as simply a mystery, supernatural and immaterial needs in our lives. I do not speak for my benefit, nor do I intend to contradict our Holy Bible, I simply draw my conclusion from true impressions and facts absorbed by one whose religious life has been neglected because of one to a million reasons encountered in our complex society. How many times do we come across this picture.

Joe Lopez goes to church merely because Mr. Gonzales the next door neighbor goes. This is exactly what I meant in past issues that a large number of our raza expect to be spoon fed. Is it not true that we must accept reality: I do not say that I am of this type tho I do not put myself a step higher than my neighbor, and maybe if we all reconsider our reasons for going to church we will do our share in accepting the true meaning of Christianity.

Personally my friend I believe church is not the

end of the line, tho the beginning of a more richful and enjoyable way of living.

I furthermore state if ever the need arises, that I will place myself in a position of indefinite results to help any juvenile or criminally inclined individual. I furthermore repeat without hesitation for which I have had the good fortune of survive this state of being so far, and let me expose to you the educator, the businessman, priest, or politician, when Johnny needs help he wants help and not excuses, sympathy, propaganda or a waiting period. And I will further share my experiences by going to the extent of speaking about social existence among ourselves, no matter if were young or old it is based on the principles of personal and moral responsibility toward our fellow individual whom needs help. Don't underestimate your child just because he obeys the golden rule set by his parents. A child can live by the golden rule and yet can go astray as well as any child whom is neglected by society. For I have been very close to friends who have parents who go to the extent of buying him a new automobile to keep him happy and after he graduates from school and is on his own he elevates himself to petty crimes and on toward grand-theft.

Just because we have the ability to succeed in achieving our limitations to cope with society is no excuse to neglect our neighbor. We must put ourselves in a position closer and more qualified to love thy neighbor spiritually and guide him to recognize the true relation of suitability.

I will at this time repeat my goal in this publication, simply to indicate to all elders concerned, disregarding church denominations that youth looks to you as an example and not at the golden rule set by you, for church is the prime foundation in any human being, just as the floor is the foundation of our home. I furthermore use a phrase expressed to me by a concerned individual whom has recently added an additional foundation in our community, for the benefit of the spanish speaking people who are concerned about youth and christianity.

This gentleman's name is Mr. John Garcia. He simply replied, I'm not solely concerned about a person's soul, but also about the sole he wears about his shoe. The location site of the new Presbyterian Church, 2155 Cunningham Avenue, services in Spanish at 7 P.M. I personally believe Mr. Garcia has had experiences not known even in existence to us, I speak about customs and traditions of foreign countries and even tours in maximum security penitentiaries.

And by my personal experiences while in juvenile institutions, I believe in being honest and sincere to my fellow mates, and felt hostile to any authority. I would think about lots of crazy things. I would not believe and accept positive answers, and retaliate with negative ideas, and I have to say I believed that our ugly society would in the future needs more individuals who are sincere and clue the people in by experience and true ideas. I decided to use this idea and felt snug in this position.

I sincerely believed in Christianity, but by far not in Churchianity. And I'm not an atheist nor am I lunny, I'm simply drawing my past ideas, to bring about my present conclusions. If you wonder why I felt this way I suggest you use common sense.

Quite often I would sit in church sermons, made mandatory by regulations. And I'll be frank, I'd say later to myself, what kind of mumbo jumbo jazz is this, he descended into hell.....

And I'd deeply become more hostile within myself, and would not accept the credibility of Genesis. At times I'd even feel that church was holy and other times sinful. Why? Simply because I've seen people whom classify themselves as Christians and use the church as, well, I'm not say!

I've seen elders participate in large church suppers, and I have nothing against church suppers, tho I'd later see these people go home and treat their children as family pets, and are lucky if they ate a good meal before bedtime. And before long I began to wonder if there was any relation between these sinful individuals and their Holy God. About this time I became confronted with other challenges, and what I was left with, scares of many phoney Christians tho how I feel is immaterial. It is up to me whether to accept Christ or not! **ATTEND CHURCH!!**

## De Charla con las Estrellas

Nuevamente, al iniciar el presente reportaje sobre la incipiente visita a nuestra blanca y bella ciudad de San Jose, de una de las mas grandes, gentiles y aplaudidas artistas cinematograficas contemporaneas, la sensitiva Libertad Lamarque, quiero agradecer sinceramente a la poderosa empresa pionera del Norte de California, como lo es la Empresa Davilla, las facilidades que siempre me ha brindado para entrevistar en nombre del EXCENTRICO, a todas las celebridades del Septimo Arte y del escenario que de cuando en cuando visitan estas uberrimas tierras californianas.

Por esta vez, como ya lo apunte en un principio, toco el turno de confesarse con EL EXCENTRICO a la inmarcesible Libertad Lamarque, que en compania de ese magnifico y unico dueto comico femenino en America que lo forman Hortensia Clavijo y Josefina Olguin conocidas como LAS KUKARAS, se presentaron en persona, en el popular Rainbow Ballroom, la noche del domingo primero del año en curso.

En espera de la llegada de la famosa diva gaucha, ama y señora del tango, entreviste primero al fantástico dueto de LAS KUKARAS quienes amablemente me confiesan que el 4 de Octubre de 1950 se iniciaron en el arte escenico, llenando un hueco dentro de su especialidad, ya que como llevo dicho, ellas forman el unico dueto comico femenino en las tres Americas. Han visitado triunfalmente Cuba, Santo Domingo, Guatemala y la Republica de El Salvador. Por primera vez visitan San Jose, y se sienten encantadas de convivir, siquiera sea por unas pocas horas con sus hermanos de raza de aquende la frontera. La simpatica y comica pareja causa muy agradable impresion en cuantos las conocen y conversan con ellas.

Libertad Lamarque, la bella mujer de la voz de arrullo y de la exquisita femineidad, se presenta minutos mas tarde escoltada por su esposo el pianista Carlos Malerba. Viste un elegante traje negro sobre el que aletea graciosamente una larga chalinilla de transparente y rosado tul. Ni una sola joya, a excepcion de una magnifica perla negra que luce en una de sus blancas y aristocraticas manos, realiza su dulce belleza. En ella, en Libertad, todo es dulzura, una dulzura exceptional y unica que realiza singularmente su persona, su voz de privilegio, su palabra, su mimica, todo lo relativo a su arte histronico. La Dama del Tango conquisto la fama de que tan merecidamente goza en la cinta de plata, casi desde que hizo su aparicion en ella, cosa por cierto bien dificil para

la generosidad de los astros y estrellas de pantalla; pero Libertad, a base de esos dos factores que siempre y en todo momento han realizado su arte y su personalidad, y que son, como ya lo dije, su dulzura y su exquisita femineidad, se constituyo en la excepcion de la regla. Ya era famosa y mundialmente aplaudida cuando salio de su patria la Republica Argentina en donde habia filmado 17 de las 55 peliculas que ha hecho hasta la fecha, todas en Mexico a excepcion de las 17 que realizara en su tierra natal. Como se ve, cabe a nuestra mundialmente famosa industria filmica mexicana, la honra de haber dado una solida madurez al arte magnifico de Libertad Lamarque. Ella es de los pocos idolos del celuloide que se siempre se advierten en un plano ascendente, merced a la generosa entrega de su encantadora personalidad en todas y cada una de sus peliculas y de su perfecta identificacion con los personajes que interpreta. Sus dos peliculas en laboratorio, cuyos titulos son: "Mi Corazon Canta", y "Los Hijos que yo Soñe", nos reservan gratas sorpresas.

La mimada artista de todos los publicos me confia que es la segunda vez que visita San Jose, y que le agrada la ciudad de los Jardines. Un afectuoso abrazo de la gran cantante rubrica esta entrevista que robustece la opinion que ya tenia formada sobre la exquisita personalidad y el arte depurado de la dulce Libertad Lamarque.

## De Charla con

The day following a National Election is a day of change. This change is inherent in politics because the political activity within a community returns to the local and state level. In California and particularly here in Santa Clara County the two major concerns to the voter favored no solutions through the casting of votes.

The agricultural industry and the Mexican-American community share together the concern over next year's harvest. The problem is not one that can be solved by uncompromising insistence nor by ignoring the issue. That this problem is complex is no more clearly shown than by the inconsistent stands taken by both elected officials and by contenders for public office in the political races of this year.

Quite obviously the Bracero program has lost its sanctity under the statutes. However, in complete devotion to political security, Governor Brown has acknowledged on the one hand that the interests of the Labor Force must be promoted while on the other hand he has offered forth his support to the agricultural industry with suggestions of utilizing Public Law 414. The situation thus remains. Either some means of harvesting the crops is guaranteed or the farmers will plan no crops for next year. In an economy not completely replaced by the Space Industry the agricultural contribution to our community still involves the lives and livelihoods of the major segment of our population. The direct effect upon the families who work in the canneries, trucking companies, grocery stores, truck and auto maintenance and even gasoline stations would leave its mark. In general each of us either directly or indirectly would be affected. If however, the interests of the Mexican American are ignored by a renewal of the Bracero program, the problem then becomes institutional. But the apparent destiny of next year's harvest does not lie in either of these two avenues of approach. Public Law 414 looms to the fore as the probable "solution". The provisions of this law are even less desirable than those of the bracero program. At this point there remains two major contributions that each of us can make.

The first is one of the basic premises of representative government. If we have strong and constructive ideas they should be made known to Governor Brown c/o State Capitol Bldg., Sacramento, California; and to Congressman Gubser, c/o House Office Building, Washington, D. C.

A letter or telegram (there are special rates for Public Opinion telegrams) from each voter in the districts which these legislators represent would certainly make them cognizant of all sides of the issue. The other contribution could be a considerable addition to the sociological advancement of our community.

Through such an organization as the Mexican American Civic Council the efforts of the various other organizations could be coordinated for stronger voice and action.

Expansion of programs for civic improvement could possible include some such function as an inspection and endorsement of the facilities offered in contract to the labor force should PL 414 become implemented. This approach of constructive voluntary action could upgrade the standard of living for the labor force and be of benefit to the whole community.

The second major concern to the voter which remains today as an emotional, social, and economic problem is the extremely controversial issue of discrimination in housing. An approach to this problem by the peoples of our community is essential at this time. For if the members of our community do not take action then the spokesman for all of us will probably be one not of our choosing.

Again the utilization of the existing organizational structures coordinated through one well accepted and efficient body could make great strides in accomplishing the goal of fairness in housing.

On this last point I would personally like to have anyone who is interested in working on this problem to contact me.

### DAMON y PITIAS

Una de las mas grandes pruebas de amistad que se recuerda desde la antigüedad hasta nuestra época, es la amistad de los filosofos griegos, del tiempo de Dionisio el Joven en Sicilia.

Sin poder precisar a ciencia cierta cual fue la razon por la cual Pitias fue condenado a muerte por Dionisio; el filosofo fue sentenciado a ser decapitado. Dionisio le concedio el permiso, con la condicion de que su amigo Damon ocupara su lugar como reo sentenciado a muerte y en caso de que Pitias no regresara el dia y la hora de cumplir la sentencia el amigo seria decapitado. Damon acepto quedar en lugar de Pitias hasta que este regresara; se llevo el dia de la ejecucion y el amigo no habia regresado. Dionisio ordeno que se ejecutara la sentencia en la persona de Damon, que habia quedado en lugar del reo.

Se levanto el cadalso y la plaza se lleno de gente que se congrego para presenciar el sacrificio, se trajo el prisionero que sin ninguna protesta ni resistencia y con toda serenidad, se dispuso a morir en lugar de su amigo; cuando el verdugo levantaba la espada para decapitar a Damon, aparecio Pitias que por un accidente sufrido en el camino de regreso, apenas habia tenido tiempo de llegar a entregar su vida al verdugo y salvar la de su amigo que iba a morir en su lugar.

Dionisio presencio la escena en que se ponía de manifiesto la verdadera amistad demostrada por los dos amigos; se conmovio en lo mas profundo de su corazon y perdono a Pitias, suplicando que le permitieran formar parte de esa amistad que se profesaban los dos filosofos.

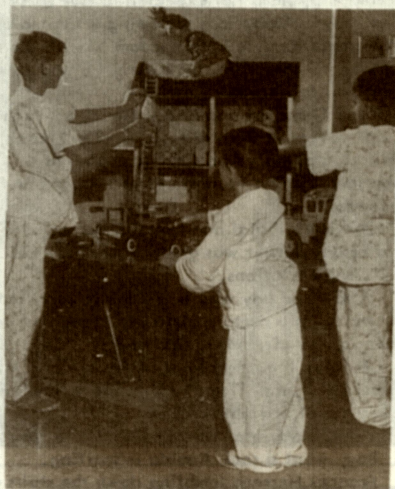
