Policy #SP 07-11 Revision to the Constitution of the Academic Senate (Section 3B Membership)

Purpose of the Policy: To include and identify the deans and associate deans for Academic Affairs as ex-officio members of the Academic Senate

Existing Constitution:

Section 3. MEMBERSHIP:

- A. Voting members of the Academic Senate are as follows:
 1. elected representatives of the faculty-- including those tenured and probationary, professional library personnel, lecturers;
 2. a student representative appointed by the Associated Students.

- B. Ex Officio Members of the Academic Senate are non-voting. They are as follows:
 1. the University President;
 2. the University Vice Presidents;
 3. the Associate Vice Presidents for Academic Affairs;
 4. representatives of Student Affairs Personnel;
 5. representatives of the staff; and
 6. representatives of technology services.

Proposed Revision to the Constitution:

Section 3. MEMBERSHIP:

- A. Voting members of the Academic Senate are as follows:
 1. elected representatives of the faculty-- including those tenured and probationary, professional library personnel, lecturers;
 2. a student representative appointed by the Associated Students.

- B. Ex Officio Members of the Academic Senate are non-voting. They are as follows:
 1. the University President;
 2. the University Vice Presidents;
