Nevertheless I have amended into an existing bill provisions concerning condors which we believe to be in the best interests of conservation. It was too late to introduce another bill and Mr. Lowrey kindly consented to the amendment.

Amendment to assembly bill No. 2533 introduced by Mr. Lowrey.

Sec. 3. Section 1179.5 is added to said code, to read:

Notwithstanding any provision of Sections 35, 1155.5, and 1179, or any other provision of law, it is unlawful to take any condor at any time or in any manner. No provision of this code or any other law shall be construed to authorize the issuance of a permit to take any condor and no such permit heretofore issued shall have any force or effect for any purpose on and after the effective date of this section.
