2. Review of Education Specialist: Mild/Moderate Disabilities Credential Level II
 - Mazingo asked for clarification on what is mild/moderate
 - Denney stated that mild/moderate is usually students with learning disabilities, behavior disorders, high functioning autism and ADHD.
 - Cordeiro asked was the difference between Level I and II
 - Denney answered Level I is the initial credential and is good for up to 5 years. After the 5 years a teacher must obtain a Level II credential. The Level II credential is focused on advanced methodology and assessment. Students applying for a Level II credential must already have a Level I.
 - Cordeiro asked how long it would take a student to complete the credential.
 - Denney stated that students must be working at the same time so it would take a student 2 years attending the program part-time.
