*At the beginning of the 1983-84 academic year, Cal State Bakersfield was not going to have a yearbook. Through the efforts of the Associated Students, however, we will again be able to have a valuable memento of our educational achievements and social experiences at CSB.*

*In addition, students of the 19-campus CSU system were faced with increased student fees. On July 21, 1983, the CSU system budget was slashed by nearly \$90 million. Student fees were substantially hiked for the third time in 14 months, raising nearly \$73.1 million from increased student fees. These fee hikes included an average \$246 per full-time student, an additional \$36 first-time ever post baccalaureate fee, and a \$5 increase in the application fee.*

*Through efforts in the statewide student leadership, however, the Associated Students have renewed an on-going commitment to higher education. In 1984-85, CSU students will be receiving a \$42 decrease in fees.*

As a result, the award winning Runner has firmly entrenched itself as a part of Cal State Bakersfield.






A yearbook is a very important part of a college. It is as much as institution as the school newspaper. If such a program is lost, students will be missing something, especially those who are graduating.


