NEW STYLE FOR THE OLD REGISTRATION DRIVE

Democrats United needs volunteer registrars for three Saturday registration walks through selected precincts, on August 23rd, September 13th and September 27th.

Instead of each going his own way, volunteers will meet first as a group. in Community Center Park at 7th and Hobson Way in Oxnard, at 9:15 A M. Nearly 5000 new Democrats were registered in the 18th State Senatorial District (Senator Gary Hart's) and the 35th Assembly District (Assemblyman Jack O'Connell's) during the recent Democratic registration drive but more registrations are necessary, especially in specific areas, before Democrats can win a significant number of offices.


