

105. Development and Learning (3)

Prerequisite: admission to credential program (concurrent enrollment in E Ed 131T allowed). Facts, ideas, and principles fundamental to an understanding of educational procedures in teaching and learning, and to the growth and development of children.

106. Tutorial Reading (3) (Former E Ed 120T section)

Designed to give the student direct involvement with a child who has reading problems; practical experience that uses the knowledge, skills and techniques obtained in the prerequisite basic reading course. (2 lecture, 2 lab hours)

120T. Problems in Elementary Education (3; repeatable with different topics)

Summer Session 1974: Children's Literature; Reading in the Elementary School; Language Arts in the Elementary School; Social Studies in the Elementary School; Math in the Elementary School; Science in the Elementary School; Curriculum in the Elementary School; Teaching Culturally Disadvantaged; Teaching Kindergarten; Language Development In Migrant Education. Prerequisite: admission to credential program; E Ed 105. Study in depth of various areas in elementary education.

135. Audio-Visual Education (2) (Same as S Ed 135)

Prerequisite: E Ed 105. Types and use of materials and equipment in the classroom; laboratory work in operation of equipment and appraisal of materials.

142. Selection and Uses of Library Materials (3) (Same as S Ed 142)

Selection and use of materials for school media centers according to the needs of children and the educational goals of the school program.

148. Organization of School Library Materials (3) (Same as S Ed 148)

Prerequisite: E Ed 147 and admission to credential program or permission of instructor. Acquisition, cataloging, classification, and allied processes for a materials-centered school library. Practice in cataloging and classifying library materials; development of a sample catalog.

157. Conservation of Natural Resources (3) (See Biol 157)**160S. Field Work in Teaching Problems (1-6; max total 12)**

Eaton School and McCardle School June 17-July 26. Prerequisite: E Ed 132B or teaching experience. For in-service teachers to study selected problems in elementary education. Problems studied through directed observation and participation in summer school and through library research; guest lectures.
