Argument

We demand that, in the next ten years, Detroit recycle 83,000,000 autos into a public transportation system which will send 200,000,000 Americans on their appointed rounds quietly, swiftly, economically and without pollution.

If the burial of this one auto can do some small bit to bring these changes it will have helped all men, black, brown, white, and yellow to survive.

The United States has 83 million cars.
