Few facts have changed since Ms. Lynch gave this talk last year.

Notably BHP Billiton lost their bid to build a LNG terminal 14 miles of the coast of Malibu, CA, only to be replaced by NorthernStar's proposal 10.5 miles of the coast of San Buenaventura (Ventura), CA. there may be a connection that all new and proposed natural gas pipelines head east out of the Rocky Mountains, none head west towards California.

Kinder Morgan Energy Partners, L.P. and Sempra Pipelines & Storage are in the process of building a 1600 mile pipeline from the south east Wyoming hub to Ohio which will carry 2 billion cubic feet a day ( Bcfd ) of natural gas.

"Gas flowing from Wyoming and Colorado to the east has been constrained by inadequate [ pipeline ] capacity. Most of this gas has either been used locally or moved down the Kern River Pipeline to markets west of the Rocky Mountains." ( Apache Corporation report ) Kern River Pipeline delivers 1.8 Bcfd to California.

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
