Assemblyman Joseph Montoya, Majority Whip of the Assembly will be the special guest at a fund raising barbecue, on Sunday April 25th, sponsored by the Jane Tolmach for Assembly Committee.

"My campaign committee and I extend a welcome to Assemblyman Montoya, and his family, and are very pleased that he could join us for our fundraising event, Jane Tolmach said in announcing the event. "Assemblyman Montoya, as Chairman of the Assembly Select Committee on the Implementation of Career Education will play an important role in the discussion of the 4 year college for Ventura County, and I hope to be able to demonstrate to him the critical need for that college as a means of increasing career opportunities for many residents of Ventura County.

In a special legislative session in 1974 Assemblyman Montoya became only the fourth freshman legislator in this century to be elected to the important Assembly Rules Committee. Assemblyman Montoya also serves on the Agriculture and Education committees of the Assembly. In addition he was chosen as the Chairman of the Chicano Caucus by his fellow Chicano members of both the Assembly and the Senate.

Before being elected to the State Assembly, Montoya worked as a Social Services Counselor with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Social Services. He has also served as a Councilman from the City of La Puente from 1968-1972, and as Mayor in 1971-72. In addition, Montoya has been elected the 1st Vice-Chairman of ACERO (Statewide Association of Spanish Surname Elected Officials).

"Assemblyman Montoya's background in the social services and human resources areas has enabled him to experience great sensitivity to the needs of people in both his district, as well as on the state level," said Mrs. Tolmach. "As a past fellow social services worker, I look forward to a productive working relationship with Assemblyman Montoya and other members of the legislature, in order to effectively serve the needs of the people both in the 36th District and the State as whole."
