Any person of Japanese origin is welcome and urged to attend this meeting.

The American Friends Service Committee has been asked by the federal government to take over the responsibility of relocating students of San Jose State college of Japanese ancestry.

Up until a few days ago, students could transfer to colleges in the middle west and east, but until some further arrangement has been made, students are not being permitted to leave restricted areas, according to the chairman of the committee.

The Friends Service Committee is attempting to work out a plan in co-operation with all groups now interested in Japanese student re-location.
