Jane will work to return and keep control of government, both local and state, where it belongs, in the hands of the people - in your hands. Mrs. Tolmach knows that for government to serve the people as it should, it must be accessible to, responsible to, and accountable to those who own it - you and I.

Mrs. Tolmach will work hard to reverse the current trend of gathering more and more decision making power to the state level. Few people have the time, money or special ability to effect change at the Sacramento level, but the special interest professionals are up there and are working hard. As much policy setting and decision making as possible should be left at the local level under the close scrutiny of local people. At this level elected officials can more easily be held responsible for their acts.

Jane will work against shifting the cost of state government down to local property owners. State government should not attempt to balance its budget by shifting state costs to local government. It creates economic inequities and unmanageable economic burdens.

Mrs. Tolmach knows there is a need for a four year college in Ventura County. There is a serious economic burden placed on those county people who want to continue their education beyond the community college level. Jane will explore methods of bringing to Ventura County the educational levels its people deserve to have.
