The boxes of the last carload of columns, etc. have not been opened except one crate, which gave evidence of the contents being broken. It is one of four packed by Elmore and the breakage was due to method used - the ends of the column havin no support. I have sent it down to San Simeon as it is needed and will have the best repairs possible made. The break was not a clean one, but fractured off a dozen or more small fragments.
