

PATRICK J. SULLIVAN TO BECOME COUNTY'S
NEW REGISTRAR OF VOTERS IN 1962

Howard W. Campen, Santa Clara County Executive, announced today the appointment of PATRICK J. SULLIVAN as Registrar of Voters effective January 1, 1962.

Mr. Sullivan will replace G. Eber Tarleton who is retiring after 17 years of service.

Sullivan, a 1942 graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, and a World War II Navy veteran, entered County service as Assistant Director of Central Services in 1954. He was promoted to Business Manager of Public Works in June 1958, and will continue to serve in that capacity until he takes over the Registrar's office.

Sullivan lives at 2780 Cherry Ave., San Jose. He is married and is the father of four children.

Eber Tarleton, a World War I veteran, began his career with the County as Clerk of the Superior Court in 1945. He was appointed Assistant Registrar of Voters in 1947, and Registrar on September 1, 1948.

Tarleton, who lives at 1018 Hazelwood St., San Jose, has a daughter in San Jose, a son who is a Navy Commander, and five grandchildren.







GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE OLD AGE SECURITY LAW

PURPOSE: Old age security shall be paid to every person who is in need and who meets the requirements of the law. The assistance shall be administered promptly and humanely, and without discrimination on account of race, religion or political affiliation.

APPLICATION: Every applicant for old age security shall file a written application with the county welfare department in the county in which he resides.

The applicant may sign the application within 60 days of reaching the 65th birthday or any time thereafter. The application is made on a form provided by the county welfare department. Only that information will be sought which is necessary to carry out the provisions of the law. ID documents, letters, or other material pertaining to age, residence, property, etc. are assembled and shown at the county welfare office when making application, this will hasten the determination of the eligibility of the applicant.

Persons physically unable to make application in person may authorize another person to make application for them.

Information may be obtained and applications may be filed at the county welfare department office in your county.

A copy of the Old Age Security Manual of Policies and Procedures and department bulletins may be purchased through the State Department of Social Welfare for \$3 including sales tax.

INVESTIGATION: The county welfare department is required to make an investigation of every application to determine if the person is eligible to receive aid. This investigation must be started promptly. It must be completed and payment must be made to eligible persons as soon as possible after the application is signed. In order that the necessary investigation can be made every person who signs an application must also give the county written authority to investigate assets and income, if any.

The investigation of an applicant must be continued until all of the facts which are necessary to determine the person's eligibility have been secured.

The law contains a special provision to insure prompt restoration of aid to recipients whose aid was discontinued because of income from employment.

Cash on hand, in a bank account or safe deposit box, in postal savings, on deposit with building and loan associations or otherwise held where it is payable on demand; stocks, bonds, notes, mortgages, deeds of trust, etc. Exception: Proceeds received from the sale of real property shall be considered real property for one year after receipt. Proficed the proceeds are to be used to purchase a home.

Automobiles and motor vehicles of all kinds, if not needed for transportation.

The cash-surrender value of life insurance.

The market value of all other items of personal property other than the value of personal effects of the applicant or recipient.

"Personal Effects" include clothing, household furniture and equipment, foodstuffs, fuel and personal jewelry. The value of these items is not counted when determining personal property holdings.

TRANSFER OF PROPERTY: One who voluntarily assigns or transfers property to another for purpose of qualifying for aid is ineligible.

RELATIVES: Responsible relatives are the spouse and adult children. Responsible relatives living within the state who are financially able are required to contribute to the support of the applicant or recipient. (The Governor just signed legislation to modify the state old age security law by relieving those whose net income is less than \$400 a month from the responsibility of contributing to their parents' support. Also stricken from the law are provisions requiring a

relative to submit to the county a form stating his ability to pay. Relatives will be able to ask the Social Welfare Board to modify their contributions).

INCOME: The income from all sources must be insufficient to meet the applicant's needs. Income commonly includes earnings, net income from real or personal property, civil and military pensions, social security payments received from the federal government, contributions from relatives and others.

In cases where the applicant receives Social Security in an amount less than the state pension grant, the state will make up the difference. For instance, if an applicant receives \$33 from the social security the state will make up the rest for a total of \$95.

After January 1, 1961 the total state grant will be \$100.00.

AMOUNT OF OLD AGE SECURITY PAYMENT

Old Age Security is granted on the basis of need. The maximum grant to meet basic needs (i.e., normal living expenses; such as food, housing, clothing, transportation, incidentals, etc.) is \$95. (Will be upped to \$100 by the first of the year) However, many persons have needs other than basic needs, and such other needs are called "special needs". Special needs may include the cost of medical and dental care, boarding and nursing home care, as well as other items. Certain medical needs (including some prescriptions) may be provided under the MEDICAL CARE program.

When an applicant or recipient of old age security has special needs, total need is the sum of \$95 plus the cost of the items of special need.

When the applicant or recipient has no income less than \$20 a month, his total need, up to \$115 a month, can be met from his income and his old age security grant. For example, a person with total need of \$113 a month and income of \$10 a month is able to meet \$10 of his \$113. Need from his own income.

Old age security of \$103 a month is granted to meet the balance of his \$113 need. If his total need were \$125. a month and his income \$10. a month, he still could meet \$10 of the \$125. need.
