Upon request of treasurer for privilege of banking money, Mrs Riley moved that treasurer be granted that privilege. Carried.

The recommendations were then taken up in order + discussed.

Mrs. Mabley moved that the secretary send for sample copies of "Woman Citizen" before subscribing for it. Carried.

After discussion it was decided to leave luncheon until later date.

It was moved by Mrs. Mabley, seconded by Mrs. Latimer that the article of publicity be given to the papers. After discussion of items to be incorporated into article the motion carried.

Mrs Latimer, ch of Com. on plans for "Clean up Week" gave an interesting report of conference with City officials and Chamber of Commerce heads, all of whom gave promise of cooperation in the work. Mrs. Mabley moved that the Clean-up Committee be empowered to make plans and go before the City Council two weeks from date.
