June 21st 1891

Dear Budw.

I borrowed this paper from Emma who
borrowed it from Kittie. There has nothing been
heard from the Brunks yet and Kittie said last
year there was a week getting here. Mrs Schlessinger
with child and nurse arrived last night she
will have to spend her time with me as the only
other body is Mrs Baldwin and she is very
deaf. Emma is contented with Edith her sister Minnie
who is a nice quiet girl. Kittie and her sister -
congenial souls. Marie Blom and her two friends
and the boy Guy Wayman are all way together.
and that's all that are here. There is a picnic
the young ones play or bang on continually in the
parlor. I was fortunate in securing the cottage
I did, it is the sunniest, and far enough from
the house, the two Darls are in it with us.
The nights are very cold, the air is very like
mountain air. breezy and clear. Though it
threatened to rain again this morning. It
is very sleeping place. Emma and I will rest
for a certainly as there is nothing to do
I do hope you are feeling well and that
Papa and Pami Bens and all Aunt's
family are well. We all send our love
I do not think it would pay Aunt to
come up here as I do not think the table
or beds would suit her. Don't forget to
have the sister Perine do your dresses
you could rest up here. But I think

you'd find it dead. but I know it would
be a benefit to you. There is a chance
for this to go over to Highland Springs so
I thought I'd better write and say we are
all well. Dollie moved from the Werners to
East Oakland and has a weeks old
baby girl. I hear that is it will be when
you get this it was born last Monday. I also
hear Capt Simpson is dead. If you would
like bugs. I can get you any kind in large
quantities inside or outside the house.

I took one out of my ear and found a
worm under my head when I got up
this morning. Emma sleeps with me. There
was not enough bed clothes for three beds
it is so cold at night. Mrs Schlessenger says
she never was so cold in her life as she
was last night. Emma and Kittie
are in Hammocks side by side. pre-
tending to read. You don't know how I
miss all of you. Be sure you give
George something green to eat.
