Dear Supporter,


As you may know, the initiative petition, which would grant the people the right to be heard on airport location in Ventura County, was circulated and enthusiastically supported. Over 14,000 signatures were obtained in a surprisingly short time. Of the people approached, we estimate that 95 per cent were in support of the initiative ordinance.

Unfortunately, when the petition was presented to the County Clerk for counting and to be presented to the Supervisors for passage or the setting of an election, the County Clerk refused to count the signatures. We feel the refusal stems from the Supervisors' continued insistence that they, and not the citizens, should choose airport locations.

Consequently, Steven J. Stone, the City of Camarillo and I filed a lawsuit (on June 23, 1971) in the Superior Court of Ventura County to compel the County Clerk to do his duty on behalf of the citizens. The case has been scheduled to be argued and heard on July 19, 1971 at 9 a. m. in the Superior Court of Ventura County.

Financial support of our many-faceted endeavors is needed and welcome.
