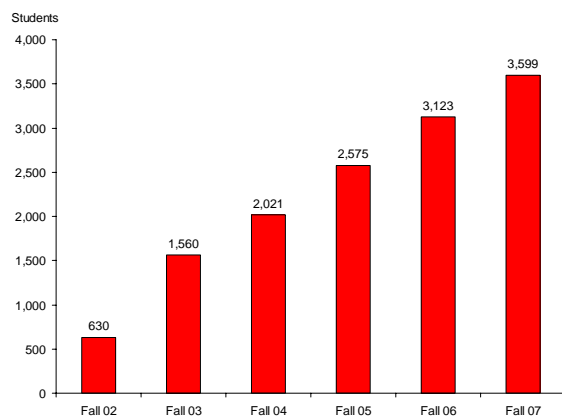




## Student Profile Fall 2007

### Undergraduates

#### Total Enrollment, Fall 2002 – Fall 2007



CSUCI opened its doors to upper-division students (Juniors and Seniors) in Fall 2002, and admitted its first Freshmen class in Fall 2003.

Enrollments have grown steadily over the last six years to the current level of 3,599 total students.

On average, CSUCI undergraduates take a course load of 13 units per semester. FTEs are calculated by dividing total units by 15.

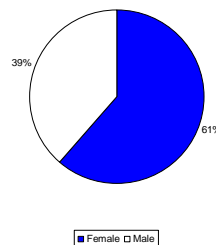
Ninety-one percent of students are undergraduates who are enrolled in eighteen majors. This student profile describes **CSUCI Undergraduates**.

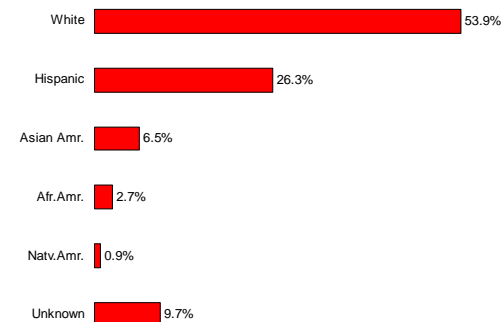
Eighty percent of CSUCI undergraduate students are full-time students taking 12 or more units each semester.

#### Race/Ethnicity for Undergraduates

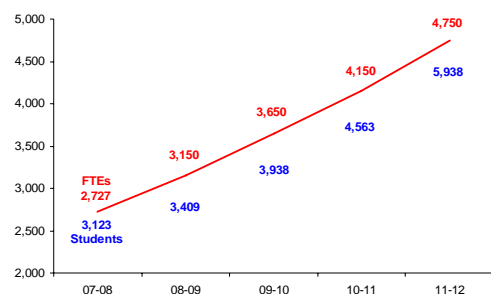


According to self-reports of Race/Ethnicity, more than one-half of CSUCI students are White, and more than one-quarter of students are Hispanic.

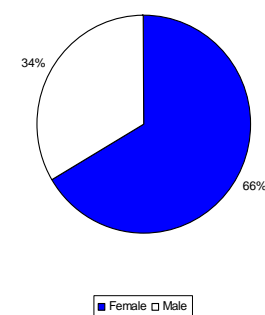
## Graduating Senior Data

Eligibility for graduation is determined by the total number of units completed as required by the major; and degrees are awarded by semester. CSUCI has awarded degrees to students each semester of operation.

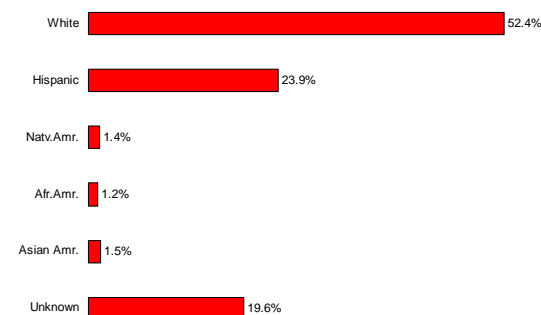
The number of state-supported students that have graduated through Summer 2007 totals 1,555.
