

The first event is today (Oct.16) as part of Homecoming Week. Activities include the 2013 Blue Light Stroll Off stomp/dance competition between multi-cultural fraternities and sororities on campus.

Food for tonight's event will be sponsored by Buffalo Wild Wings. It will also feature games such as foosball, air hockey, ping pong and darts.
