Enrollments in JC District Surpass Last Year by 1,044

More than 1,000 additional students will attend the Kern Junior College District this fall, Dr. Edward Simonsen reported last night to the district board.

"Enrollment on the three campuses totals 11,196," he said. "Last year the total enrollment was 10,152."

According to Dr. Simonsen, every campus showed a gain in daytime and evening attendance. The most dramatic growth was at Porterville College where the

percentage increase for the day was 29 per cent and for the night 61 per cent. Registration shows 930 students for daytime classes and 412 for the evening.

At the Bakersfield campus the daytime enrollment is 5,376 compared with last year's figure of 5,132. The evening division reports 3,568 entering this fall reflecting an increase of 445 students.

The registration this fall at the Desert Campus in Ridgecrest, both day and evening, totals 910.
