FALL QUARTER ENROLLMENT, 1979-83  
-----FTES BY DEPARTMENT AND PROGRAM-----

Similar information on enrollments was published in FIB-1883 dated 1 March 1983 for winter quarters 1980-83, under FIB-2583 dated 30 June 1983 for spring quarters 1980-83, and under FIB-0384 dated 13 July 1983 for academic years 1979/80 through 1982/83. Please refer to those bulletins for caveats on interpreting trends in enrollment data.

Table I of the attached provides data on FTES Enrollment by Departments for the fall quarters 1979 through 1983. As in similar tables, enrollment is credited to the departmental "home" of the faculty member. In the five-year period covered, Arts and Sciences shows the most consistent growth pattern with the largest numerical increase being in Mathematics (82.9), English (50.6), Physics & Geology (28.9), Nursing (28.4), and Fine Arts (24.1). The greatest numerical declines have been in History (38.5), Economics (16.9), Foreign Languages (16.4), and Psychology (16.2). Leave patterns, allocation of positions and other factors influence the number of FTES accommodated but consistent growth or declines in each of the five fall quarters probably has some significance.

The most notable growth in Business over the five years has been in Marketing (53.6) and the most notable decline in Finance (29.3). Teacher Education has increased by 17.1 FTES, whereas Special Programs has declined by 56.9, partly because of a shift in faculty from that department to Teacher Education. Physical Education has declined by 45.3.

Table II provides a fall quarter FTES enrollment comparison for the five years from 1979 through 1983. Data for fall 1979 in both Business programs and in both Public Administration programs is skewed as a result of efforts in that quarter to move large numbers of students into an unclassified or undeclared status. The most significant program growths have been in Geology where enrollment has tripled over the five-year period and Health Sciences which almost doubled. The growths in Business Administration BS and MBA and in Public Administration BA and MPA have been substantial but less striking than appears from the figures because of the change in status mentioned above. The Single Subject Credential program has also grown but the figures for Fall 1979 are faulty and on the low side as are those for several other Education programs including Bilingual/Cross Cultural.

Table III provides data on the number of majors enrolled for the fall quarters from 1981 through 1983 along with the number of majors eligible to attend in fall 1983 and the preference of undeclared students for a specific major. Undeclared applies only to undergraduates. There are no preferences given for graduate programs except Early Childhood which persistently has one undergraduate. Baccalaureate programs that admit majors as freshmen also have no undeclared preferences.
