# What has Ken MacDonald

done for Ventura County?

## SUPERVISOR

In six years as Ventura County Supervisor, *Ken MacDonald* was a leader in:

- ★ Creating Channel Islands Harbor in Oxnard
- ★ The incorporation of Simi Valley, Camarillo, and Thousand Oaks
- ★ Locating the 3M Corporation in Camarillo
- ★ Cut the Matilija Dam capacity in half to prevent structural failure
- ★ Consolidating Ventura County Municipal Courts
- ★ Bringing the North American Science Center to Thousand Oaks
- ★ Establishing restrictive land use planning
- ★ Consolidating sewage treatment in the Ojai Valley



## A SIX-YEAR RECORD

*Ken MacDonald* has consistently anticipated the concerns of his constituency. While others spouted political rhetoric, *Ken* was fighting. Look at his record:

- ★ Was the first to require counties to create a drug abuse program.
- ★ Was two years ahead of the current bandwagon to require all campaign contributions to be made public.
- ★ Was the sponsor of legislation making welfare fraud punishable as a felony.
- ★ Was the first to crack down on out-of-state drug distributors selling illegal narcotics

## IN THE STATE ASSEMBLY

Few legislators have accomplished more in a lifetime than *Ken MacDonald* has in just six years.

In 1966, *Ken* was a freshman in the Assembly trying to learn the ropes. By the years' end, he was designing the ropes.

He entered the Legislature as a fiscal conservative and social moderate. That description hasn't changed, but he has put his many administrative talents to good use.

Few areas can boast the service *Ken MacDonald* provides Ventura County.

The Assemblyman works closely with Camarillo Mayor Don Livingston and the city staff.





- ★ Was the first to restrict car dealers from adjusting auto mileage odometers.
- ★ Was a leader in requiring careful open-space planning.
- ★ Was responsible for providing emergency flood relief for Ventura County.
- ★ Was the sponsor of legislation allowing appeals from unfair planning commission decisions by private citizens.
- ★ Was responsible for funding a Motor Vehicles office in Thousand Oaks.
- ★ Was the first Assemblyman to insist on recorded committee votes.
- ★ Was an early leader in the fight to make college campuses an arena for education, not politics.

In six years, *Ken MacDonald* has established a warm, working relationship with Minority Floor Leader Bob Monagan



## THE DO-ER IN A "DO-NOTHING" LEGISLATURE

While the Legislature in 1972 was fumbling tax reform, coastline protection and no-fault insurance, *Ken MacDonald* was:

- ★ Battling to reform the Legislature including opening all hearings to the public.
- ★ Working to protect the Ventura County natural resources including a ban on strip-mining in the Los Padres National Forest, saving the palm trees in Camarillo, preserving the Mugu State Park, and investigating contaminated marine life.
- ★ Demanding a much-needed safety-barrier on the Conejo Valley stretch of Highway 101.
- ★ Funding a Motor Vehicle office for Simi Valley.
- ★ Revamping the State's data processing system, saving taxpayers \$150 million over 5 years.
- ★ Finding additional aid for neglected small school districts in Ventura County.
- ★ Beginning his Chairmanship of the important Joint Legislative Committee to Revise the Education Code.
- ★ Pushing a study to review the path of Highway 101 through the Camarillo area.
