October 6th 1878

Dear Boy.

There is nothing particular to write about but suppose you'll expect a letter. This is Sunday night. Father did not come up last night and Mother was disappointed - yesterday was not a good day for her. break so short - I expected she'd have a bad ~~day~~ night but she did not - has been better today - the Doctor says she is not losing anything. I think the children worry her even the little she sees of them - but I do not want to send them to Brooklyn. Julia will come up this week and settle things -

This morning Avery woke up - sat on my head said "Papa home! papa home! seemed to give him great satisfaction - then he sat on

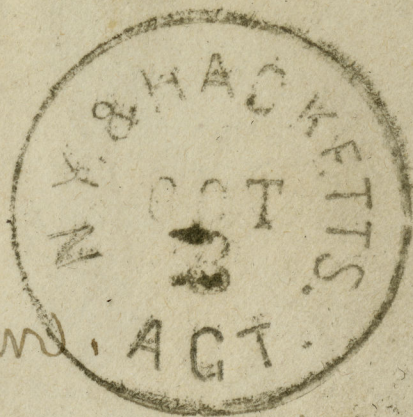
Indus until he woke her up - They are all well
and send their love to Papa - I don't think they
have any idea about where you are -
Of course I wish you were here - I miss
and shall continue to miss you.

My cold is very bad, worst I ever had and
it don't get better - my throat is very sore and
I cough incessantly. I think I will not write
anymore tonight - Mother sends her love -
I did not go to church today.

Oct 8th 1878

This afternoon I received your Albany
letter for which I thank you - glad you
were progressing so well. It is raining
tonight and Mother has not been so well
today - she is wanting to go home - so I
guess she'll go next week - My cold is
worse than ever - a terrible bad throat -

the children are well with the exception of
slight colds. Arny was painfully aching last
night. The children send their love and
kisses to Papa. I've heard nothing from
Pam. Sonia gets on all right with the children.
Emma does not mind her grandma at all.
at dinner today Dadu turned a whole
dish of tomatoes onto the table cloth.
Mother is in bed and I must follow.
There is no news that I know to write you.
The children send their love to Charlie and
Alice and Eddie Platt. Give my love
to Mrs Taylors. Don't forget to take care
of yourself and "Bell Bonanza" -
your loving
