Dear Andrew -

I congratulate you on having

is room for both - (the pupil & teacher) -
That is very low prices for currants - last
year I paid 35 or 40 - got 'em late - Don't
waste yourself out on jelly - I trust your
teeth will give you no more trouble - And
that Aunt will take you on a Pic-nick -
To get money from Papa and buy those
children a lot of firecrackers -
We got back from Blue Lake last night
about 8 o'clock had a pleasant time,
but none of us wanted to stay there -
Sam does not care to go back for the
4th and wants no firecrackers I don't
think they'd be safe here anyway -
I may stay here until after the 4th

as I do not want to go back to Lake
land so soon, and the Springs near
here I do not care for - Avey is going

have been hot - today it was just a 100°
when I went in to dinner - now its 98°
on the back porch in the coolest place
