## **Human Resources Course Offered by CSUCI**

Camarillo, Calif., February 24, 2005 -- A nine-session preparation course for designations as a Professional in Human Resources (PHR) and a Senior Professional in Human Resources (SPHR) will begin Thursday, March 3, on the campus of California State University Channel Islands.

The course, aimed at human resource practitioners seeking certification or professional development, provides a comprehensive review of core human resources topics such as strategic management, workforce planning, human resource development, compensation, and labor relations.

The course will be held on Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings to accommodate working professionals. Here is the schedule: Thursdays, 6 to 9 p.m., March 3 and 10 and April 21; Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., March 19 and 26 and April 2, 9, 16, and 23. A certification exam will be held Saturday, May 7.
