The precise agenda of what is to occur in the four scheduled sessions of the 1968 Democratic National Convention was still clouded with uncertainty as the time neared this weekend for the Monday opening session.

Despite valiant efforts by the California Delegation staff as well as the leadership of the campaigns for McCarthy, Humphrey, McGovern, Maddox, and one or two curious newsmen, details as elementary as the starting time for the opening session were not yet available from the offices of the Democratic National Convention as this first DAILY REPORT went to press.

However, the following basic schedule can be surmised from information gathered, including past convention programs.

The convention will be called to order on Monday evening at approximately 7:00 pm. Welcoming speeches and opening ceremonies will consume this preliminary round of the convention bout.
