The Ateliér is organized by Self-Help Graphics with the intention of giving a select group of artists of varied backgrounds, styles and aesthetics an opportunity to work together in a format largely determined by the artists themselves. The objectives of the Ateliér are to give all of the participants the maximum degree of freedom possible in individually and collectively exploring: to manipulate the screenprint medium in the process of conceiving, and executing their respective pieces.
