

**104. Nursing of Persons with Behavioral Maladaptations (2) (Initial Offering 1977-78)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 102L, 103L, 105B; Nurs 104L, 106, 106L concurrently. Speech 4, 162 or Soc Wel 124 recommended. Eclectic presentation of theories and concepts as they apply to the dynamic treatment of patients suffering from mental illness.

**104L. Clinical Practice with Patients Suffering Behavioral Maladaptations (3) (Initial Offering 1977-78)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 104 concurrently. Application of nursing theory in caring for patients suffering from a major mental illness with special focus in interpersonal skills and the nurse's role in common treatment modalities. (9 lab hours)

**105A. Biopsychosocial Dysfunction (3)**

Prerequisite: admission to the nursing major, Micro 20, 21; Nurs 1, 1L concurrently; Psych 101 or H Ec 39 prerequisite or concurrently. Theories of stress and causation related pathologies and therapeutics. Homeostatic adaptive mechanism in preserving integrity of function; pathologic processes and effects. Principles of therapy to restore balance of function capacity.

**105B. Medical Therapeutics (3) (Former Nurs 180T)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 1, 1L, 105A; concurrent with the first upper division course of clinical nursing. Nature of the drug action and interactions; physiologic effects of pharmacologic agents; clinical uses, indications, and precautions in drug therapy; assessment of patient responses and implications for nursing interventions.

**106. Principles of Leadership and Management in Nursing (2) (Initial Offering 1977-78)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 100, 100L, 101, 101L, 102, 102L, 103, 103L, 105B; Nurs 106L, 104, 104L concurrently. Application of organizational theories and concepts in the delivery of nursing care in a variety of settings.

**106L. Clinical Practice of Leadership and Management in Nursing (3) (Initial Offering 1977-78)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 106 concurrently. Application of special skills in organization, delegation, coordination and evaluation in the delivery of nursing care in a variety of settings. (9 lab hours)

**110. Nursing of Children (3)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 27, 27L, Psych 101 or H Ec 39 (or permission of instructor); Nurs 110L concurrently. Theoretical aspects of nursing care of children including health maintenance, common illnesses, the relationship of illness to growth and development, and family relationships.

**110L. Nursing of Children Laboratory (3)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 110 concurrently. Laboratory experience with children at various points in the health-illness continuum. (9 lab hours)

**114. Public Health Science (2)**

Prerequisite: Concurrent with first semester in Nursing major. Trends in public health administration, organization, functions; national, state, local, public, voluntary agencies; interpretation and use of vital statistics; environmental health and epidemiology.

**124. Medical-Surgical Nursing II (3)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 109, 109L, 110, 110L, 119, 119L; Nurs 124L concurrently. Total patient care utilizing a problem-solving approach.

**124L. Medical-Surgical Nursing II Laboratory (3)**

Prerequisite: Nurs 124 concurrently. Laboratory experience in planning and directing nursing care for individuals and groups of patients. (9 lab hours)

**125. Introduction to Research for Health Professions (3)**

Prerequisite: Statistics. Basic concepts of research and evaluation and application of research findings in health practice.
