

"SER", Service, Employment, and Redevelopment comes from the saying "para a ser alguien".

In November 1966, the Region Four Chapters of the American G.I. Forum got the Albuquerque (Regional Office) Jobs for Progress, Inc. At that time Representatives of these Chapters met and elected a Board of Directors. Hugo Bayona from San Jose was seated as Chairman; Daniel Tellez, from Milpitas, as Vice-Chairman; Dimitrio Reyes, Newark, as Secretary; Pat Vasquez, Luis Ybarra, and Nick Gonzales all from San Jose and Ignacio Balli Jr. from Hayward as Members.

Since formation of this Board, we have incorporated under the title of "Project Ser, Jobs for Progress, Inc., State of California, Bay Area Region". Our central office is 97 Boston Avenue, Suite 108, San Jose. The Board has drafted a justified "Proposal" for a Center to be located in San Jose, in the multi-million dollar figure. This Proposal is now in Washington D. C. awaiting approval and finding from the Department of Labor, and O.E.O. The Board is optimistically certain that funding of an appreciable amount will be made available shortly after the Fiscal year.

The "Seed" monies (\$79,000) that I mentioned in my last column will be available within the first two weeks of April. Also "bids" have been advertised and applications submitted for the following positions in San Jose. 1. STATE DIRECTOR: Duties and responsibilities will be direct and implement policy, and be responsible for full implementation of the component projects' goals and objectives within California; Supervise staff; Coordinate with and report to the Regional Office. 2. FIELD REPRESENTATIVE: Work under administrative direction of the State Director, maintain liaison with target cities within the State; Develops and maintains

working relationships with related agencies within those cities; assists in the development of Manpower Programs, assists in the expansion of services of the State Office. 3. SKILLS BANK DIRECTOR: To establish and administer job placement, job development, relocation and referral services; and Coordinate services with the Regional Office. 4. STENOGRAPHERS five positions. 5. SECRETARY ASSISTANT to Skills Bank Director.

I would like to point out a very important aspect of our program that concerns each and everyone of you. I can't over-emphasize the necessity of your cooperation and participation, in our Registration Drive. Please don't drop the Ball! The Skills Bank, I repeat the Skills Bank is a Job Records Center set-up. It will be nation-wide, and the California Skills Bank will be tied-in with the Regional Office, who will serve every State in the Nation. Briefly, the purpose is to have everyone register with their present job, trade, etc., and/or availability for advancement. Even though you are completely satisfied we are, and as you are, please remember that our efforts are for those who are not. Therefore, we ask you to please take one minute of your time to register with us. We hope to have a huge success with our Skills Banks and especially with the capability of the (IBM) processing equipment in the Regional Office. Our Registration Drive will be highlighted on April 21, 22, and 23rd.



Mr. Estrada, who regularly goes to the border for his products, generously volunteered to Sister Bravo the cargo of a huge truck destined for La Piedad, but left it in Calexico, one year ago.

Board members contacted the Sub-secretary of the Federal Ministry of commerce and industry were granted the necessary permit this was a first time concession for goods delivered to La Piedad.







CONDENADA A MORIR

Como herida por una puñalada en pleno corazón, la madre dió un grito y se desplomó inconsciente cuando oyó la terrible sentencia; su querida hija Rosaura estaba condenada a morir dentro de seis meses. La larga y dolorosa lucha en la cual se habían agotado todos los recursos disponibles en un desesperado esfuerzo por salvarla, sólo había servido para prolongar su martirio. Rosaura, joven y bonita, esposa cariñosa y madre abnegada de tres preciosos niños, desde su camara de tortura moral y material vería llegar la primavera con su alegre y fragante floración, vería llegar el verano pleno de sol, trayendo abundantes frutas, dulce regalo de la tierra generosa, y vería pasar los días bajo el ritmo de la risa cantarina de sus hijos y el dolor silencioso de sus padres y de su esposo. Y por último, vería su pobre comida humana consumirse lentamente hasta el día en que la muerte piadosamente vendría por ella.

Ayer estuve a visitarla, ocho días después de la fatal sentencia. Rosaura llevaba un vestido estampado con flores de vivos colores en un fondo amarillo en el cual su alta y esbelta figura lucía maravillosamente. Bajo la tenue luz de su habitación, el color rojo de las cortinas y tulipanes en profusión, la palidez de Rosaura contrastaba dramáticamente imprimiendo en ella una exótica belleza. Mirándola allí acogedora y sonriente, era imposible concebir la idea de que ella era víctima de una terrible enfermedad que estaba devorando su vida incontinentemente. El cáncer que había hecho presa de ella había sido detectado demasiado tarde, de modo que todas las posibilidades de curación habíanse desvanecido.

Rosaura habló lentamente, presa de un amargo remordimiento. "Toda la culpa es mía", dijo, y ante mi reacción de sorpresa, ella continuó, "Si, la culpa es mía porque no dí la debida importancia a los prime-

ros síntomas de mi enfermedad. Quiero decir que en lugar de acudir al médico traté de curarme yo misma con aguas medicinales y aspirinas. Así estuve varios meses hasta cuando alguien me dijo que mi enfermedad podría ser cancer. Entonces, siguiendo el consejo de una amiga mía acudí a la Sociedad Americana de Lucha Contra el Cancer (American Cancer Society). Para ser mas precisa, llamé por teléfono a esa Sociedad y recibí una amable respuesta en español cuando les dije que hablaba muy poquito inglés. Entonces ellos enviaron una señora a mi casa quien se encargó de llevarme al hospital. Allí me examinaron, y como tú sabes, hicieron todo lo humanamente posible, pero era demasiado tarde porque la enfermedad había progresado a tal punto que todo tratamiento resultó infructuoso. Bueno, tú conoces el resto. Los médicos no me dan más de seis meses de vida. De modo que viviré solo hasta el próximo verano".

Había en la voz de Rosaura una profunda e indecible tristeza y con el pequeño pañuelo que estrujaba entre sus manos temblorosas, recogió las lágrimas que finalmente se desbrodaron incontinentes por sus mejillas.

Cuando salí de casa de Rosaura comencé a caminar sin rumbo fijo. Me sentía completamente sobrecogido de dolor y desorientado. De pronto un nombre vino a mi mente, la American Cancer Society. Entonces tomé una decisión, iría allá para informarme de cómo ellos trabajan. Acudí a la guía telefónica y encontré la dirección: 379 W. San Carlos, teléfono 297-0527. Llamé y me contestó la señora Rosa Romero quien, cuando le dije mi propósito, me dijo que sería bien venido. Una vez en su oficina ella me explicó que la American Cancer Society estaba empeñada en una campaña de divulgación sobre el cáncer entre la comunidad de habla española, que para ello la sociedad contaba con folletos en inglés y español, con películas y con personas versadas en la materia. Todo lo que la sociedad requería era la colaboración de la gente, y explicó que cualquier persona podría organizar una reunión de vecinos y amigos y pedir a la sociedad una personas que vaya a enseñarles las películas y a hablarles sobre la ayuda que pueden recibir de dicha institución cualquier rato que necesiten. La señora Romero enfatizó la necesidad de que toda persona deber tener un conocimiento fundamental de los síntomas del cáncer para acudir en procura de atención médica cuando la enfermedad todavía puede ser combatida, y no demasiado tarde, como

en el caso de Rosaura.

Ojalá que esta pequeña historia conti-
tuya un mensaje para todo aquel que la lea y
haga que se interese por la información ne-
cesaria sobre el cáncer. Si esto es así, po-
dría decirse que se ha contribuido de cierto
modo a salvar la vida que bien puede ser la
propia nuestra o la de cualquiera de nuestros
seres queridos.


