

RESOLUTION NO. 5349

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OXNARD APPROVING THE MASTER IMPROVEMENT PLAN OF AN APPROXIMATE 7.5 ACRE NEIGHBORHOOD PARK TO INVOLVE BASKETBALL, VOLLEYBALL, TENNIS COURTS, PICNIC AREAS, SOFTBALL DIAMOND, A TOT LOT PLAY AREA, RESTROOM FACILITIES AND AN ALL-PURPOSE FIELD LOCATED IN NEIGHBORHOOD NO. 32 OF THE SOUTH COMMUNITY AS REQUESTED BY THE CITY OF OXNARD PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Oxnard has reviewed the Master Improvement Plan for the development of an approximate 7.5 acre neighborhood park including basketball, volleyball, tennis courts, picnic areas, softball diamond, a tot lot play area and an all-purpose field, located in Neighborhood No. 32 of the South Community as requested by the City of Oxnard in accordance with Article VII, Section 65402 (c) of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Director has determined that the project covered by this application will produce no substantial impact on the environment, and a declaration to this effect has been duly executed and posted in accordance with the guidelines established by the City of Oxnard; and

WHEREAS, said commission finds that after due study and deliberation, the following circumstances do exist:

1. That the proposed use is in conformance with the General Plan, Specific Plan and other adopted standards of the City of Oxnard.
2. That the proposed use will not adversely affect or be materially detrimental to the adjacent uses, buildings or structures or to the public health, safety or general welfare.
3. That the site for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate the yards, walls, fences, landscaping and other items as might be required.
4. That the site for the proposed use will be served by streets and highways adequate in width and structure to carry the kind and quantity of traffic such use will generate.

5. That the site for the proposed use will be provided with adequate sewage, water, fire protection and storm drainage facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission of the City of Oxnard hereby approves said additional facilities to the existing public recreational facility.
