Stop the BHP Billiton LNG Terminal

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Significant and potentially irreversible impacts off the Malibu Oxnard coast.

July, 2006: The largest mining company in the world wants to build a **Liquefied Gas Terminal** off the coast of Malibu and Oxnard. This massive floating LNG **three football fields long** and **14 stories high**. It would receive and store L flammable gas, from huge LNG tankers that would arrive at least two to three from foreign countries overseas.

This project poses **significant and potentially irreversible impacts** to our environment and the health and safety of our children. We can stop it, but this project may be approved as early as **November 2006**.

CCPN (California Coastal Protection Network) is working tirelessly to defeat this massive project. We need your help.

▶ Ask the Governor to Veto the Terminal

▶ Help Pass SB 426 in July and August

In July and August, tell your California State Legislators and Governor Schwarzenegger you want them to pass and sign into law **SB 426** (Siman) "Informed Choice for California". This legislation will be heard in the Legislature during the first two weeks of August. If passed, it will go to the Governor's desk for his signature. **SB 426** would require the state to evaluate all the potential LNG project alternatives **BEFORE** approving the massive floating LNG terminal.
