

ADMISSION

Graduate students from abroad follow the same procedures as do all other graduate students, except that the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is required of all students whose native language is not English. Exception may be made for students transferring from American colleges and universities with grades that demonstrate full competence in English. TOEFL scores, applications, and academic documents should reach the CSU, Fresno, Admissions Office at least six months before the semester for which admission is desired. For further information, write to the School of Graduate Studies.

Graduate students with a total score of less than 500 on TOEFL will not ordinarily be admitted to graduate study at CSU, Fresno. Exception may be made for students who are otherwise admissible and who satisfactorily complete an approved program in English as a foreign language. In this circumstance, the university may grant provisional admission subject to satisfactory completion of the work and submission of acceptable TOEFL scores.
