Gaffery gave a short Power-point presentation reviewing the background of parking on campus, the consultation process that was used to determine the need for a student parking fee increase to support a parking garage, and the new visitor parking policy. Several people present discussed problems that the new policy was causing, particularly for such events as concerts and plays where many attendees could not be contacted in advance to receive the visitor parking codes.

C. Edmonson represented the student view, in that students are concerned about people coming to campus and receiving free parking while students pay for an adjacent space. F. Pena noted that outreach efforts had included the codes and noted no problems with parking for potential students attending orientation events. A very wide-ranging discussion ensued. The committee will continue this discussion at the next meeting.
