

OLLI awarded grant

The Osher Lifelong Learning Institute received an award from the Osher Foundation for partial support of its program from April 1, 2007 to March 31, 2008. This is the fourth year of support from the Osher Foundation in the amount of \$100,000 per year. In spring 2008, OLLI-CSUCI will be eligible to apply for an endowment grant of \$1 million.

Enrollment now open for Faculty and Staff in OLLI Courses

The fall session of the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at CSUCI is now open for enrollment. Each eight-week course meets once a week for two hours. Courses are intended for mature learners, ages 50 and older, who seek intellectual enrichment without the distraction of grades, tests, or degree credits. Among the 13 fall classes are evening courses in Simi Valley—Non-Violence and Social Conflict, and Classical Mythology, and a Saturday class in Thousand Oaks—19th Century Romanticism in Music. The remaining classes are on weekdays from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. or 1 to 3 p.m. on campus or in Ventura. For CSUCI employees over 50, OLLI offers a 10 percent discount on fees.
