They include: sprinters, Bob Wright, Jim Olson and Francis Bell; distance men, Gene Lenz, Darwin McGill and Allen Starr; backstrokers, Larry Cole and Val Geissler; breast stroke men, John Phillips and Bob Downey; butterfly swimmers, Bob Loeffler and John Carr; and divers, Leigh Allen, Norm Boudreau and Gordon Wall.

Next action for the local tankmen following this week is set for Poly Royal, April 24, when the Mustangs entertain the UC at Santa Barbara Gauchos in a 3 p.m. meet.
