DIRECTIONS FOR PREPARING AND FILING CAMPAIGN STATEMENT.

If this campaign statement is for a General Election following a Primary Election, do not include contributions or expenditures previously reported following the Primary Election.

A candidate for nomination or election to any elective office whether before, during or after an election is prohibited from either directly or indirectly, through any other person or committee, paying, expending or contributing any money or other valuable thing or promise to do so except for lawful expenses. Lawful expenses are defined in Section 11504 of the Elections Code.

Every person who is a candidate must make and file a campaign statement. The campaign statement must show in detail all moneys furnished to the candidate or to others in his behalf and all moneys expended by the candidate or by others in aid of his campaign. The campaign statement must also show the names of all persons who furnished such moneys and the names of all persons to whom such moneys were paid. The specific nature and purpose of each item and service for which money was spent must also be shown.

TIME FOR FILING: The campaign statement must be filed by the candidate within 35 days after the election or primary, or not later than one day preceding the day on which the candidate takes office, whichever first occurs.

PLACE OF FILING: Candidates for offices to be filled by the voters of the state or any political division greater than a county and for members of the Senate and Assembly, Representative in Congress, or members of the State Board of Equalization or judges of the Superior Court must file one copy of the campaign statement in the office of the Secretary of State and must also file a copy with the clerk of the county in which the candidate resides. Candidates for all other offices must file one copy of the campaign statement in the office of the clerk of the county in which the election is held.

No fee or charge whatsoever shall be made or collected by any officer for the verifying, filing or recording of any campaign statement. No officer shall issue any certificate of nomination or election to any candidate until his campaign statement has been filed. No other statement of expenses shall be required. Every person is guilty of a misdemeanor who violates any of the provisions of Chapter 1, Division VII of the Elections Code relating to expenditures by or for candidates, and any candidate convicted for any violation thereof is disqualified from holding the office for which he was a candidate at the time of violating said provisions.
