Shall they be green with white tops?

As to Thermometers: There are no registering thermometers on hand in San Francisco, so have wired for five of them. Will have them located as follows, unless you send word otherwise:

- #1 in center of "Top";
- #2 in orange grove below A;
- #3 in rose garden;
- #4 on orchard site;
- #5 on west slope of garage hill.
